## ANALYSIS:

An Act to declare what shall be deemed Title. the Ordinary Revenue of the Colony, and to provide for the regulation by the General Assembly of the Costs of collecting the same.

[4th August, 1858.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

I. The Revenue arising from all existing or future taxes, what shall be deemed duties, rates, imposts, fees, fines, penalties and forfeitures, payable General Revenue. to Her Majesty, in respect of or collected by, the several Departments of the Government, Courts, and Officers, specified in the Schedule to this Act, shall be deemed and taken to be Her Majesty's Ordinary Revenue of the Colony of New Zealand, subject to be appropriated for the public uses thereof.

II. So much of the sixty-second Section of the Constitution Part of Section 62 Act as authorises and requires the Governor to pay out of the and Section 63 of Revenue arising from taxes, duties, rates, and imposts levied under any Act or Acts of the General Assembly all the costs, charges, and expenses incident to the collection, management and receipt of such Revenue, and also the sixty-third Section of the same Act, are hereby repealed.

III. All costs, charges, and expenses of, or incident to the collection, management, and receipt of the Ordinary Revenue of the Colony as defined by this Act, and of every part thereof, shall be provided for and regulated from time to time by laws to be passed by the General Assembly for that purpose.

Commencement of Act.

IV. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1858.

Short Title.

V. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Ordinary Revenue Act, 1858."
