AN ACT to amend "The Miners' Representation Act Amendment Act 1862." Title.

[30th October 1865.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Miners' Representation Act Amendment Act 1865."

II. Section IV. of "The Miners' Representation Act 1862" is hereby Short Title. repealed and in lieu thereof it is enacted as follows—

When in any Province in which there is a duly proclaimed Gold Field but in which no Gold Fields Member of the House of Representatives or of the Provincial Council shall have been by law appointed to be elected every person qualified under the provisions of "The Miners' Representation Act 1863" shall be entitled to vote at the election of Members of the General Assembly or Provincial Council respectively for the electoral district in the Province in which the Miner's Right or Business License held by him as aforesaid shall have been issued. In mining districts where no Gold Fields Member holders of Miners' Rights may vote for members of House of Representatives and Provincial Councils.
