AN ACT to appropriate certain sums to be raised under "The New Zealand Loan Act 1863" and other Acts. Title.
[8th October 1866.]

WHEREAS out of the loan of three million pounds sterling authorized to be raised by "The New Zealand Loan Act 1863" and "The Debentures Act 1864" and other Acts amending the same it is expedient that a sum of one hundred and seventy thousand pounds out of moneys should be appropriated for the purposes hereinafter mentioned Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Loan Appropriation Act 1866." Short Title.

II. Out of the sum or sums of money authorized to be raised by "The New Zealand Loan Act 1863" "The Rate of Interest Act 1864" "The New Zealand Loan Act 1865" "The Debentures Act 1864" and "The Debentures Act 1864 Amendment Act 1865" there shall be issued and applied any sum or sums of money not exceeding one hundred and seventy thousand pounds for defraying the charges which will come in course of payment subsequent to the thirtieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six for the costs and charges incident to the employment and location of Military Settlers. £170,000 appropriated for employment and location of Military Settlers.
