AN ACT to authorize the Appropriation for certain Title.  
Purposes of the Annual Sum of One Thousand  
Pounds for Four Years out of the Provincial  
Revenue of the Province of Wellington.

[15th September, 1873.]

WHEREAS at a sitting of the Provincial Council of the Province Preamble.  
of Wellington, on the fourteenth day of May, one thousand  
eight hundred and seventy-three, the following Resolutions  
were duly passed, that is to say:—

In Committee, fourteenth May, one thousand eight hundred and  
seventy-three, on the motion of Mr. Brandon :

Resolved, That an address be presented to His Honor the  
Superintendent requesting that he will recommend to this  
Council an appropriation to be made out of Provincial  
Revenue of the sum of one thousand pounds (£1,000)  
per annum for four successive years, including the current  
year, for the salary of Head Master of the Wellington  
College, and for the establishment of one or more Profes-  
sional Lectureships on Natural Science and Chemistry in  
connection with that Institution.

“That with a view to the removal of any doubt which  
exists as to the power of a Provincial Legislature making  
an appropriation beyond the period of one year, His Honor  
be further requested to cause to be proposed to the General  
Assembly a Bill authorizing and requiring him to pay such

Provincial appropriation to the Governors of the Wellington College for the respective purposes above named.

“Resolutions agreed to fifteenth May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.”

And whereas it is expedient to give effect to such Resolutions :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Wellington College Vote in Aid Act, 1873.”

Superintendent to pay over money.

2. The Superintendent of the Province of Wellington may issue and pay over out of the revenues of the said Province, for each of the four years commencing from the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, and ending on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, unto the Governors of the Wellington College, the sum of one thousand pounds (£1,000), to be applied by the said Governors in or towards the payment of the salary of the Head Master for the time being of the said College, and in or towards the establishment of one or more Professional Lectureships on Natural Science and Chemistry in connection with the said College, in such manner in all respects as the said Governors may think fit and expedient.

Moneys to be paid over as if appropriated by Provincial Act.

3. The moneys to be issued and paid over under the authority of this Act shall be so issued and paid over as if the same had been duly appropriated in each year by an Appropriation Act of the Superintendent and Provincial Council of the Province of Wellington, and were issued and paid over in pursuance thereof.
