An Act to authorize the Payment of a portion of the Title. Land Revenue of the Province of Taranaki in aid of the funds of a Harbour Board to be constituted for the Harbour of New Plymouth.

[22nd August, 1874.]

DE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The New Plymouth short Title. Harbour Board Endowment Act, 1874."

2. From and after the constitution of a Harbour Board by or One fourth part (or under any Ordinance of the Provincial Council of the Province of such less part of land revenues to be fixed Taranaki, passed in pursuance of the provisions of "The Harbour Boards" by Legislature of Act, 1870," (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act,") there shall from province) to be paid to Harbour Board of time to time be paid over to such Harbour Board one fourth part, or New Plymouth. such less part as shall be fixed by the Legislature of the said province, of all revenues arising from the sale occupation or other disposal of the waste lands of the Crown within the said province; and such moneys, when so paid, shall form part of the funds of such Board, and be applicable by it to any of the purposes mentioned in the fourteenth section of the said Act, or in the Ordinance under which the Board is constituted or in any Ordinance amending the same.
