AN ACT to authorize the grant of a Retiring Allowance to Wilson Gray, Esquire, a Judge of District Courts, on his retirement from Office.

Title.

[31st August, 1874.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Governor should be empowered to grant to Wilson Gray, Esquire, a Judge of District Courts, on his retirement from office by reason of ill-health, a retiring allowance in excess of that which may, under the existing law, be granted to him :

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Wilson Gray Pension Act, 1874.”

Short Title.

2. Upon and after the said Wilson Gray ceasing to hold such office as aforesaid by resignation by permission of the Governor, on the ground of ill-health, there shall be paid to the said Wilson Gray, out of the Consolidated Revenue of the colony, a pension for the term of his natural life after the rate of three hundred pounds per annum.

On Wilson Gray ceasing to hold office, he to be paid a pension of £300.

3. The said pension shall commence on the day on which the said Wilson Gray shall cease to hold office as aforesaid, and shall be paid quarterly.

Pension payable quarterly.
