AN ACT to amend "The Crown Grants Amendment Act, 1870."

[27th August, 1880.]

CROWN GRANTS
AMENDMENT.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Crown Grants Amendment Act, 1880." Short Title.

2. The words "of the facts therein certified," in the fourth section of "The Crown Grants Amendment Act, 1870" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), are hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof there shall be substituted the following words, that is to say, "that such persons are jointly and severally liable to pay the said fees." Amending section 4 of "Crown Grants Amendment Act, 1870."

3. The words following are hereby added to the sixth section of the said Act, "Provided that any such complaint may be laid at any time after the matter of such complaint arose, anything in 'The Justices of the Peace Act, 1866,' to the contrary notwithstanding." Complaint for fees due may be laid after matter arose.

4. This Act shall be held to have been and to be incorporated with the said Act from the coming into operation thereof. Act incorporated with said Act.

AN ACT to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account to the Service of the Year ending the Thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one. [27th August, 1880.]

IMPREST SUPPLY
(No. 4).

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

£200,000 advanced
on Imprest towards
service of year ending
31st March, 1881.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, 1880 (No. 4)."
2. Out of the Public Account there may be issued and applied, towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty by way of Imprest for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, in addition to the sums mentioned in the Civil List Act, "The Imprest Supply Act, 1880," "The Imprest Supply Act, 1880 (No. 2)," "The Imprest Supply Act, 1880 (No. 3)," and other Acts, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole two hundred thousand pounds (£200,000), to be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of Parliament for appropriating the Public Revenues of the colony for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one.

DISEASED CATTLE
PROCLAMATIONS
VALIDATION.

AN ACT to validate certain Proclamations purporting to have been made under "The Diseased Cattle Act, 1871."

[27th August, 1880.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Diseased Cattle Proclamations Validation Act, 1880."

2. All acts, matters, or things made or done by any person under or in virtue of any Proclamation, Order in Council, notification, or appointment purporting to be made under "The Diseased Cattle Act, 1871," or under "The Diseased Cattle Act Amendment Act, 1873," are hereby declared to be and to have been valid and effectual to all intents and purposes from the date on which any such act, matter, or thing may have been made or done respectively, notwithstanding that any such Proclamation, order, notification, or appointment may have been made before the fourteenth day of August, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, which was the day appointed for the coming into operation of the Act hereinabove first mentioned.

JOINT-STOCK
COMPANIES ACT 1860
AMENDMENT.

AN ACT to amend "The Joint-Stock Companies Act, 1860."

[27th August, 1880.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is desirable to further amend "The Joint-Stock Companies Act, 1860:"

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Joint-Stock Companies Act 1860 Amendment Act, 1880."

Association may be
formed under
"Joint Stock Com-
panies Act, 1860,"
without addition of

2. Where any association is about to be formed under "The Joint-Stock Companies Act, 1860," as a limited company, if it proves to the Registrar of Joint-Stock Companies in the district in which such association seeks to be incorporated, that it is formed for the purpose of promoting commerce, art, science, religion, charity, or any other useful object, and that it is the intention of such association to apply the profits, if any, or other income of the association in promoting its objects, and to prohibit the payment of any dividend to the
