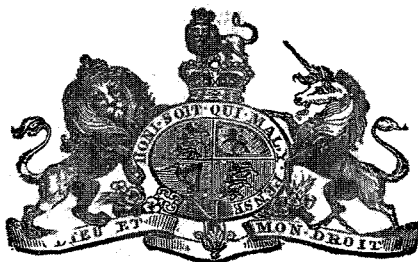

AN ACT to grant an Allotment of Land within the Borough of Hawera to the Corporation thereof as an Endowment.

[16th September, 1889.]

WHEREAS the Borough Council of Hawera made application on the twenty-fifth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, to the Minister of Lands for the grant of several town sections forming parts of a reserve appropriated for the public purposes of the Crown, as endowments for the said borough, and several of such sections being required for public purposes could not be granted, but the aforesaid Minister consented to the grant of town section number five to the said borough, and it is expedient to give effect to such promise:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Hawera Borough Endowment Act, 1889.”

2. The land described in the Schedule hereto, being portion of a reserve within the Borough of Hawera known as the Blockhouse Reserve, is hereby vested for an estate in fee-simple in the Corporation of the Borough of Hawera as an endowment for the said borough, subject to “The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886.”

SCHEDULE.

ALL that portion or parcel of land in the Provincial District of Taranaki, containing by admeasurement 31 perches, more or less, being Section No. 5 on the plan of the subdivision of Block XIX., in the Town of Hawera. Bounded towards the north by Section No. 4, 200 links; towards the east by part of Section No. 15, 97 links; towards the south by Section No. 6, 200 links; and towards the west by Princes Street, 97 links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less.
