An Acr to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account and Title. other Accounts to the Service of the Year ending the Thirtyfirst Day of March, Nineteen hundred and twelve. [21st September, 1911.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Imprest Supply Act, 1911 short Title. (No. 3).
- 2. In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there may be Impress grants. issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending
- the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and twelve,— (a.) Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the Public Account) specified in the First Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole six hundred and ninety-five thousand pounds, as set forth
 - (b.) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, not exceeding in the whole one hundred and forty-six thousand two hundred and twenty pounds.
- 3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter To be charged as to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of expressed in future Parliament for appropriation the multiple session of Act. Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the Dominion for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and twelve.
