An Act to authorize the Construction of certain Railways. [7th November, 1912.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Railways Authorization Act, short Title. 1912.
- 2. The Governor may from time to time, in the name and on Certain railways behalf of His Majesty, undertake or enter into contracts for the authorized. construction of the railways mentioned in the Schedule hereto to the extent specified in that Schedule.

3. The cost of constructing such railways shall be paid out of How cost to be defrayed. moneys to be appropriated for that purpose by Parliament.

- 4. This Act shall be deemed to be a special Act (authorizing Act to be deemed the construction of such railways to the extent specified in the Schedule hereto) within the meaning and for the purposes of the Public Works Act, 1908, which Act is, so far as applicable, hereby incorporated with this Act.
- 5. So much of the Schedule to the Railways Authorization Repeal. Act, 1910, as authorizes a portion of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway from Gisborne southwards is hereby repealed.

East Coast Main Trunk From Makaraka in a westerly and southwesterly direction to Hangaroa. Length about twenty-six miles. 4. Foxton - New Plymouth (Opu-From Foxton-New Plymouth main line to Opunake. Length about twenty-three miles. nake Branch) 5. Wellington-Napier (Featherston-From Featherston to Martinborough. Length Martinborough Branch) about eleven miles. 6. Hurunui – Waitaki (Culverden – From Culverden to Waiau. Length about Waiau Branch) fourteen miles. 7. Waitaki-Bluff (Balclutha-Tua-From Balclutha to Tuapeka Mouth.
