1912, No. 12.—*Local.*

AN ACT to vest in the Westland Hospital and Charitable Aid Board certain Crown Lands situate in the Mahinapua Survey District of the Provincial District of Westland in the Dominion of New Zealand. Title.
[26th October, 1912.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Westland Hospital and Charitable Aid Board Vesting and Empowering Act, 1912. Short Title.
2. In this Act "the Board" means the Westland Hospital and Charitable Aid Board. Interpretation.
3. All that parcel of land (hereinafter called the said parcel of land) described in the Schedule hereunder written is hereby vested in the Board as an endowment. Land in Schedule vested in Board.
4. Notwithstanding the vesting of the said parcel of land in the Board, the Warden for the time being of the Westland Mining District shall continue to have and exercise all powers conferred upon him by the Mining Act, 1908, and all the provisions of that Act shall apply to and be exercised over the same, and the vesting of the said parcel of land as aforesaid shall be subject to all legal rights and mining privileges existing at the commencement of this Act. Warden to retain certain powers.
5. All the revenue to be derived from the said parcel of land shall be payable into the General Fund of the Board. Disposal of revenue.
6. The deposit in the office of the District Land Registrar at Hokitika of a plan of the said parcel of land made and certified by a duly authorized surveyor, as required by the Land Transfer Certificate of title.

Act, 1908, together with a copy of this Act, shall be sufficient authority to the said District Land Registrar for the issue of a certificate of title to the said parcel of land in the name of the Board.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that area in the Westland Land District, being Reserve No. 271, containing by admeasurement 500 acres, more or less, situate in Block VII, Mahinapua Survey District: bounded by lines commencing at the south-western corner of Section No. 2153; thence bearing $119^{\circ} 20'$, distance 5379 links; bearing $215^{\circ} 50'$, distance 1503 links; bearing $205^{\circ} 50'$, distance 1022 links; bearing 190° , distance 1884 links; bearing $131^{\circ} 30'$, distance 800 links; bearing $210^{\circ} 30'$, distance 2323 links; bearing $163^{\circ} 30'$, distance 1137.1 links; bearing $245^{\circ} 13'$, distance 930.6 links; bearing $299^{\circ} 20'$, distance 7104.9 links; bearing $25^{\circ} 48'$, distance 2746.5 links; and bearing $33^{\circ} 08'$, distance 5600 links, to the place of commencement: excepting the Hokitika-Ross Railway Reserve.
