Title.

AN ACT to amend the Fisheries Act, 1908.

[27th October, 1914.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title:

1. This Act may be cited as the Fisheries Amendment Act, 1914, and shall form part of and be read together with the Fisheries Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section ninety-three of the principal Act is hereby amended—

(a.) By omitting all words after the words “both days inclusive,” and substituting the words—

“Provided that on the written application of any registered acclimatization society the Governor may, by notice in the *Gazette*, fix other dates for the commencement and duration of the close season, but so that in no case shall the close season be for a less period than five months”; and

(b.) By adding the following subsection:—

“(2.) For the purposes of this section the Tourist and Health Resorts Department shall, in respect of the Rotorua Acclimatization District, be deemed to be a registered acclimatization society.”

3. Section ninety-four of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the words “single-river licenses” in paragraph (e), the words “monthly licenses, weekly licenses.”
