Title.

AN ACT to extend the Duration of the Companies Amendment Act, 1922. [22nd August, 1923.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Companies Amendment Act, 1923.

Extension of duration of Companies Amendment Act, 1922.

2. (1.) The Companies Amendment Act, 1922, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and no longer.

Consequential repeal.

(2.) Section four of the Companies Amendment Act, 1922, is hereby repealed.
