Title.

An Act to amend the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920. [29th August, 1923.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Municipal Corporations Amendment Act, 1923, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Municipal Corporations Act, 1920 (hereinafter referred to as

the principal Act).

2. It shall be, and be deemed at all times heretofore to have been, lawful for the Council to permit the Mayor or any Councillor to travel without charge on any tramway or other service established

for the conveyance of passengers and conducted by the Council.

3. The Council may hire or may acquire and maintain mot

3. The Council may hire, or may acquire and maintain, motorcars or other means of conveyance for use in the performance by the Mayor and Councillors of their official duties.

4. The Council may, with the prior approval of the Minister, from time to time prepare and publish handbooks, abstracts, or other publications containing information and matters of interest relative to the history, administration, or affairs of the borough.
