2. (1) Part I of the War Legislation Amendment Act, 1916, and the several amendments thereof, in so far as those enactments are in force on the passing of this Act, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-five, when they shall be deemed to be repealed.

(2) The Rent Restriction Act, 1933, is hereby repealed.
