1937, No. 1.—*Local and Personal.*

AN ACT to empower the New Plymouth Borough Council to expend Moneys for the Maintenance and Development of the New Plymouth Borough and the District adjacent thereto as a Tourist Resort and Watering-place. [6th November, 1937.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the New Plymouth Borough Council Empowering Act, 1937.

2. (1) The New Plymouth Borough Council may from time to time apply any moneys in its General Account, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of two hundred and fifty pounds in any one financial year, towards all or any of the following purposes:—

(a) The provision or doing of any thing or things which the said Council may deem necessary or desirable for the maintenance and development of the Borough of New Plymouth and the district adjacent thereto as a tourist resort and watering-place:

- (b) The advertising of the scenic and other attractions of whatsoever description of the said borough and the district adjacent thereto by any means the Council may deem necessary or desirable:
- (c) The making of grants of money to the New Plymouth Twenty Thousand Club, Incorporated, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of one hundred pounds in any one financial year.
- (2) Nothing herein shall take away, restrict, or modify any power conferred upon the said Council by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, or by any other Act.
