Title.

An Act to amend the Hamilton Borough Council Empowering Act, 1935. [11th December, 1937.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by  $_{
m the}$ Hamilton Borough Empowering Act, 1935 (hereinafter called the principal Act), the Hamilton Borough Council (hereinafter called the Council) is empowered to acquire certain lands in the Borough of Hamilton: And whereas by section two of the principal Act the time within which such power may be exercised is limited to two years from the passing of the principal Act, being the twenty-sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-five: And whereas it has been found impossible to carry out all necessary formalities within the time limited as aforesaid: And whereas it is desirable that the time within which the powers conferred on the Council by the principal Act may be extended:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Hamilton Borough Council Empowering Amendment Act, 1937, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hamilton Borough Council Empowering Act, 1935.

Empowering Amendment

2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section two Period of the principal Act, the powers and authorities conferred limited by section 2 on the Council by that section may be exercised at any of principal time within four years from the twenty-sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-five (being the date of the passing of the principal Act), and all the provisions of that Act shall apply in all respects as if the period limited by the said section two had been four years and not two years.

(2) The said section two is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words "two years", and substituting the words "four years".
