Title. AN ACT to amend the Christchurch Domains Act, 1904. [11th December, 1937.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Christchurch Domains Amendment Act, 1937, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Christchurch Domains Act, 1904.

Section 11 of Christchurch Domains Amendment Act, 1913, amended.

2. Section eleven of the Christchurch Domains Amendment Act, 1913, as amended by section two of the Christchurch Domains Amendment Act, 1923, is hereby further amended by omitting the proviso added by the last-mentioned section.

Empowering Board as to unauthorized expenditure.

3. The Board may, in every financial year, out of its General Fund or Account, expend for purposes not authorized by any Act or law for the time being in force any sum or sums not amounting in the whole to more than twenty-five pounds.
